




What does it mean to keep serving God when no one will stand with you? This month, we'll study the account of Daniel and his three friends while they were in captivity in Babylon. We'll see how they remained faithful during some really scary situations, like being thrown in a fiery furnace or a lions' den. Even through those difficult circumstances, Daniel and his friends remained faithful to God and stood up for God. We'll learn about making healthy and life-giving decisions that stand for God alone and against idolatry (the things or ideas that keep us distracted from God). We'll learn how God rules in the kingdom of men, how to remain faithful during hard moments or unfair treatment, and how God reigns forever.









EXPLORE MORE

Have you ever read a chooseyour-own-adventure book or played a game where you had to make a hard choice? It was probably hard to see the way forward. You weren't sure what was going to happen, but you had to make a choice. We live in a dark world that doesn't always love or pay attention to God. But even in the midst of that, God calls us to make the choice to follow Christ. That isn't always an easy choice, but it is always the right one. And God will always help us make the choice to live for Him. How can you live for God this week?


