Great Tips for I Can Learn About Jesus

Parents, use the following ideas to increase the impact of these stories:

- Talk with your child about baptism and what it means.
- As a family, work on memorizing 1 Peter 2:21b (ICB).
- Explore outside together to find things John may have seen in the wilderness (acorns, leaves, sticks, rocks, bugs, etc.).
- Encourage your child to point to the words **God** and **Jesus** every time they see them printed in red.
- Help your child find and count the hidden **leaves** throughout the story.
- Encourage older children to use this book as an easy reader.

Great Tips for I Can Talk to God

Parents, use the following ideas to increase the impact of these stories:

- Encourage your child to talk to God about anything he or she is excited or concerned about. Emphasize that talking to God can happen anywhere and at anytime.
- As a family, work on memorizing 1 Thessalonians 5:17. Encourage your child to practice talking to God at various times during the day.
- Discuss the value of prayer with your child. Consider keeping a family prayer journal to record prayer requests and answers to those requests. Review it often as a reminder that God hears and answers our prayers.
- Ask your child to point to the word **God** every time he or she sees it printed in red.
- Help your child find and count the hidden **watermelon** throughout the story.
- Encourage older children to use this book as an easy reader.



- Encourage your child to identify the word **God** every time they see it printed in red.
- Encourage older preschoolers to use this book as an easy reader.
- Encourage your child to find the hidden **popsicle** throughout the story.
