Sara has a fascinating story to tell about God's provision, protection, and love. She was born literally in a stable filled with farm animals in Mexico to a mother who did not want her. Sara's grandmother cared for her until she was five, then she was sent to work for various families. An Adventist couple took interest in her and she was able to go to school. When Sara was 15, they arranged for her to move to the United States, where another Adventist family helped her get established. For many years she excelled as a school teacher, as well as a manager at Dodger Stadium. Later Sara was reunited with her mother. She forgave her for all the neglect and abuse, and took care of her during the last six years of her life. Sara says, "God chose me before I was born, He always took care of me, protected me and gave me success. I have so much to thank Him for!"

Eric, a computer programmer by profession, was born and raised in Durham, North Carolina. He spent 20 years in the Air Force and went for two tours of duty in South Korea, after which he retired as master sergeant. Eric is quiet by nature but has true grit and a kind heart.

Both Sara and Eric are involved in various ministries. They are traveling to Mexico frequently, bringing food and clothing and serving orphans, homeless and abandoned elderly. Whenever there is a need at Vallejo, both Sara and Eric are first to roll up their sleeves and work diligently and sacrificially behind the scenes.
